#### **Canadia Currency**

Canadian Dollar (CAD)

#### **Time Zone**

Eastern Daylight Time (EDT/UTC -4)

#### **Electricity and Voltage**

The power sockets in Montréal are type A and B. The standard voltage is 120 V at a frequency of 60 Hz. You may not need a power plug adapter in North America, but it's always best to check with your specific device requirements.

#### **International Calls**

International access code (011) + Country code + Phone number

Canada country code: +1

#### Wi-Fi and Internet Access

- Most cafes, restaurants, and hotels in Montreal offer Wi-Fi access to customers, often for free.
   Public Wi-Fi is also available in many parks and libraries.
- A Wi-Fi connection will be available. Access information will be provided during the training. HEC Montréal is a member of the eduroam consortium https://eduroam.org; if your school is a member, you will be able to connect via the eduroam connection.

#### **Banks and Currency Exchange**

Banks are typically open Monday to Friday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Currency exchange services are widely available at banks, airports, and currency exchange kiosks

#### **Shopping Hours**

Most shops in Montreal are open from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday to Saturday. Some stores may have extended hours on Thursdays or Fridays, and some larger shopping malls may be open on Sundays

#### **Tipping**

Tipping in Montreal is customary, similar to the United States. A standard tip for good service in a restaurant is 15-20% of the bill. You can also tip taxi drivers, hairdressers, and other service providers

#### **Getting Around**

Montreal has a well-developed public transportation system, including the STM (Société de transport de Montréal) metro, buses, and commuter trains. Taxis and ridesharing services like Uber and Lyft are also readily available.

#### Montréal Weather in June


June is a pleasant month to visit Montreal, with average highs around 23°C (73°F) and lows around 13°C (55°F).
